A. Purity: freedom from defilement noun: hagnotes = II Cor.6:6

words derived from advective: hagnos = chaste, pure II Cor. 11:2/Phil.4:8/I Tim.5:22/Titus 2:5/James

3:17/I Pet.3:2/I John 3:3

another noun: hagneia = purity, chastity I Tim. 4:12/5:2 verb: hagnizo = to purify James 4:8/ I Pet.1:22/I John 3:3

B. Self-control (temperance)

noun: egkrateia = self-control (especially continence) Acts 24:25/II Peter 1:6 verb: egkrateuomai = to exercise self-restraint (in diet and chastity), to contain [oneself] I Cor. 7:9/9:25 adjective: egkrates = "strong in a thing" (masterful), self-controlled (in appetite, etc.) Titus 1:8

- II. The concept of defilement: ceremonial a type of the moral
 - A. Contact with the ritually unclean transmits defilement: Lev. 5:3/Numbers 19:20/ Jude 23
 - B. Various forms of defilement: idolatry: life dominating cravings (I Cor. 8:7); gluttony, drunkenness, excitement, covetousness
 - C. Sexual immorality is specifically referred to a causing defilement:
