

“Valleys” in the Prophets

The Valley of Vision	Isaiah 22:1, 5	Israel or Jerusalem, because God gave...visions to her prophets.
The Valley of Achor	Isaiah 65:10	The eastern extremity, contrast w/ Sharon
The Valley of Achor	Hosea 2:15	Means “trouble”; the place near Jericho where Achan died (Josh.7:26)
Tophet, Son of Hinnom	Jeremiah 7:32; 19:2	Actual valley outside Jerusalem
The Valley of Slaughter	Jeremiah 19:6	Nickname for Tophet after battle
The Valley of Hamon-Gog	Ezekiel 39:15	Means “The multitude of Gog”
The Valley of Jezreel	Hosea 1:5	Means “God will disperse (or sow)”
The Valley of Jehoshaphat	Joel 3:2, 12	Unknown location: Jehoshaphat means “Yahweh judges.”
The Valley of Decision	Joel 3:14	Apparently another name for the Valley of Jehoshaphat
The Valley of Aven	Amos 1:5	Not a real place name; means “Valley of Wickedness”
My Mountain Valley	Zechariah 14:5	East/West Valley formed by splitting of Mt of Olives; represents escape route from Jerusalem.

The “Day of the Lord” in the Prophets

Isaiah 2:12	Upon the “house of Jacob”—either Israel or Judah
Isaiah 13:6, 9	Immanent; upon ancient Babylon, inflicted by Medes (v.17)
Ezekiel 13:5	Judgment upon Judah inflicted by Nebuchadnezzar
Ezekiel 30:3	Immanent; upon Egypt, conquered by Nebuchadnezzar
Joel 1:15; 2:1, 11	Immanent; possibly the locust plague
Joel 2:31	“Great and terrible;” apparently AD 70 (compare Mal.3:5)
Joel 3:14	“in the Valley of Decision” — probably AD 70 and aftermath
Amos 5:18, 20	“darkness and not light”; the destruction coming on Israel
Obadiah 15	Immanent; “Upon all nations”; particularly Edom
Zephaniah 1:7, 14	Immanent; destruction of Jerusalem
Zechariah 14:1	The second destruction of Jerusalem, AD 70
Malachi 4:5	“Great and dreadful”; apparently AD 70 (compare Joel 2:31)
1 Thessalonians 5:2	Comes like a thief in the night; the second coming of Christ
2 Thessalonians 2:2	Should not be thought to have “come”; the second coming of Christ
2 Peter 3:10	Comes like a thief in the night; the second coming of Christ
