Matthew 6:9-10

Our Father in heaven,
Hallowed be Your name.

Your kingdom come.

Your will be done
On earth as *it is* in heaven.

I. Perceiving the relevance of the kingdom:

...in preaching

Matthew 24:14

And this ***gospel of the kingdom*** will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

I. Perceiving the relevance of the kingdom:

...in pursuing

Matthew 6:33

But ***seek first the kingdom of God*** and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

II. The difficulty of defining the kingdom of God

A. Synonymous with "the kingdom of heaven"

Matthew 19:23-24

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "Assuredly, I say to you that it is hard for a rich man to enter ***the kingdom of heaven***. And again I say to you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter ***the kingdom of God***."

Mark 1:14-15

Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching ***the gospel of the kingdom of God***, and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and ***the kingdom of God is at hand***. Repent, and believe in the gospel."

Matthew 4:17

From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for ***the kingdom of heaven is at hand***."

B. Not synonymous with “heaven”Matthew 6:10**Your kingdom come.**

Your will be done

On earth as it is in heaven.**C. Not synonymous with “the millennium”**Isaiah 9:6-7

And the government will be upon His shoulder.

And His name will be called

Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God,

Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Of the increase of *His* government and peace**There will be no end.**

Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom,

To order it and establish it with judgment and justice

From that time forward, even forever.Daniel 2:44

And in the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom **which shall never be destroyed**; and the kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and **it shall stand forever.**

Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, **“Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?”** And He said to them, “It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Romans 9:6

It is not as though God's word had failed.
For ***not all who are descended from Israel are Israel.***

E. Not some mystical inner realityLuke 17:20-21

Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation; nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, ***the kingdom of God is within you.***"

Luke 16:16

The law and the prophets *were* until John. Since that time ***the kingdom of God*** has been preached, and ***everyone is pressing into it.***

Matthew 5:20

For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds *the righteousness* of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means ***enter the kingdom of heaven.***

Matthew 7:21

Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall ***enter the kingdom of heaven,*** but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.

F. Spiritual in natureJohn 3:3-7

Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, ***he cannot see the kingdom of God.***" Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, ***unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.*** That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and ***that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.*** Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'

Romans 14:17

for ***the kingdom of God is*** not eating and drinking, but ***righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.***

III. The Kingdom as a "people"***A. Israel from Sinai till Saul***Exodus 19:5-6

Now therefore, ***if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant,*** then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth *is* Mine. And ***you shall be to Me a kingdom*** of priests and a holy nation.' These *are* the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel."

Judges 8:22-23

Then the men of Israel said to Gideon, “**Rule over us, both you and your son, and your grandson also**; for you have delivered us from the hand of Midian.” But Gideon said to them, “I will not rule over you, nor shall my son rule over you; **the LORD shall rule over you.**”

1 Samuel 8:6-7

But the thing displeased Samuel when they said, “**Give us a king to judge us.**” So Samuel prayed to the LORD. And the LORD said to Samuel, “Heed the voice of the people in all that they say to you; for they have not rejected you, but **they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them.**”

I gave you a king in My anger, and took him away in My wrath.

B. Israel under monarchs—the House of David1 Samuel 15:26-28

Lecture #2

The Centrality of the Kingdom

A. The Gospel of the kingdom of God

Mark 1:14-15

Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching *the gospel of the kingdom of God*, and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.”

Matthew 9:35

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, *preaching the gospel of the kingdom*, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Matthew 24:14

And *this gospel of the kingdom* will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

B. John the Baptist

Matthew 3:2

In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, and saying, “Repent, for *the kingdom of heaven* is at hand!”

Luke 16:16

“The law and the prophets *were* until John. *Since that time the kingdom of God has been preached*, and everyone is pressing into it.

C. The teaching of Christ

Matthew 4:17

From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, *for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.*"

Luke 4:43

He said to them, "*I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also, because for this purpose I have been sent.*"

Luke 8:1, 10

Now it came to pass, afterward, that He went through every city and village, *preaching and bringing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God.* And the twelve *were* with Him... And He said, "To you it has been given to know *the mysteries of the kingdom of God*, but to the rest *it is given* in parables..."

Luke 9:1-2, 11

Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. *He sent them to preach the kingdom of God* and to heal the sick... But when the multitudes knew *it*, they followed Him; and He received them and *spoke to them about the kingdom of God*, and healed those who had need of healing.

Mark 4:30

Then He said, "*To what shall we liken the kingdom of God?* Or with what parable shall we picture it?"

Acts 1:3

To [His apostles] He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and *speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.*

D. The primitive church

Acts 8:12

But when they believed Philip as *he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God* and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were baptized.

Acts 14:22

...strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting *them* to continue in the faith, and saying, "*We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God.*"

Acts 19:8

And he went into the synagogue and spoke boldly for three months, reasoning and persuading concerning *the things of the kingdom of God.*

Acts 20:25

And indeed, now I know that you all, among whom *I have gone preaching the kingdom of God*, will see my face no more.

Acts 28: 23

So when they had appointed him a day, many came to him at his lodging, to whom *he explained and solemnly testified of the kingdom of God*, persuading them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening.

Acts 28:30-31

Then Paul dwelt two whole years in his own rented house, and received all who came to him, *preaching the kingdom of God* and teaching the things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ with all confidence, no one forbidding him.

**E. The Bottom Line: Lordship of Christ &
Call to discipleship**

Acts 2:36

"Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, *both Lord and Christ.*"

Romans 10:9

that if you confess with your mouth *the Lord Jesus* and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, *you will be saved.*

Luke 6:46

"But why do you call Me '*Lord, Lord,*' and *do not do the things which I say?*"

John 8:31

Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "*If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed.*"

Matthew 28:18-20

The Progress of the Kingdom

I. The Kingdom Inaugurated

Matthew 12:28

But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely **the kingdom of God has come upon you.**

Luke 17:20-21

Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation; nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, **the kingdom of God is within you [or "in your midst"]."**

Mark 12:34

Now when Jesus saw that he answered wisely, He said to him, "**You are not far from the kingdom of God.**"

Mark 11:9-10

Then those who went before and those who followed cried out, saying:

"Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD! Blessed is **the kingdom of our father David that comes** in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

Acts 2:29-32

"Men *and* brethren, let *me* speak freely to you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. Therefore, being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that of the fruit of his body, according to the flesh, He would raise up the Christ to sit on his throne, he, foreseeing this, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, that His soul was not left in Hades, nor did His flesh see corruption. This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses.

He who sits in the heavens shall laugh;

"I will declare the decree:
The LORD has said to Me,
"You are My Son,
Today I have begotten You.
Ask of Me, and I will give You
The nations for Your inheritance,
And the ends of the earth for Your
possession.

Acts 4:24-27

So when they heard that, they raised their voice to God with one accord and said: "Lord, You *are* God, who made heaven and earth and the sea, and all that is in them, who by the mouth of Your servant David have said:

*' Why did the nations rage,
And the people plot vain things?
The kings of the earth took their stand,
And the rulers were gathered together

II. The Kingdom Resisted

A. The devil's hostility

Revelation 12

1. Now a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a garland of twelve stars. **2.** Then being with child, she cried out in labor and in pain to give birth.

3. And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great, fiery red dragon having seven heads and ten horns, and seven diadems on his heads.

Revelation 12 (cont.)

4. His tail drew a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was ready to give birth, to devour her Child as soon as it was born. **5.** She bore a male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. And her Child was caught up to God and His throne. **6.** Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days.

Revelation 12 (cont.)

7. And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought, **8.** but they did not prevail, nor was a place found for them in heaven any longer. **9.** So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Revelation 12 (cont.)

10. Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down. 11. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

Revelation 12 (cont.)

12. Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time."

13. Now when the dragon saw that he had been cast to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male *Child*. 14. But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, where she is nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent.

Revelation 12 (cont.)

15. So the serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood. 16. But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the flood which the dragon had spewed out of his mouth. 17. And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Matthew 11:12

And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and **the violent take it by force**.

Luke 16:16

"The law and the prophets were until John. Since that time the kingdom of God has been preached, and **everyone is pressing into it**.

2 Timothy 2:3-4

You therefore must endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier.

Matthew 12:28-29

But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you. Or how can one enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, **unless he first binds the strong man?** And then he will plunder his house.

Luke 11:20-22

But if I cast out demons with the finger of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you. When a strong man, fully armed, guards his own palace, his goods are in peace. But when a stronger than he comes upon him and **overcomes him, he takes from him all his armor** in which he trusted, and divides his spoils.

Colossians 2:15

Having **disarmed principalities and powers**, He **made a public spectacle** of them, **triumphing** over them in it.

Hebrews 2:14-15

Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that **through death He might destroy** him who had the power of death, that is, **the devil**, and **release** those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

2 Corinthians 10:4-5

For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.

I. The Kingdom Progressing

Colossians 1:13

He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love,

Daniel 2:34-35

You watched while a stone was cut out without hands, which struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces. Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold were crushed together, and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; the wind carried them away so that no trace of them was found. And the stone that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the whole earth...

Daniel 2:44

And in the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed; and the kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever.

Matthew 21:43-44

“Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a nation bearing the fruits of it. And whoever falls on this stone will be broken; but **on whomever it falls, it will grind him to powder.**”

Matthew 13:31-32

Another parable He put forth to them, saying: “The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and sowed in his field, which indeed is the least of all the seeds; but when it is grown it is greater than the herbs and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come and nest in its branches.”

Daniel 4:10-12

These *were* the visions of my head *while* on my bed: I was looking, and behold, a tree in the midst of the earth, and its height was great. The tree grew and became strong; its height reached to the heavens, and it could be seen to the ends of all the earth.

Its leaves *were* lovely, its fruit abundant, and in it *was* food for all. The beasts of the field found shade under it, **the birds of the heavens dwelt in its branches**, and all flesh was fed from it.

Ezekiel 31:3-6

Indeed Assyria *was* a cedar in Lebanon, with fine branches that shaded the forest, and of high stature; and its top was among the thick boughs...its height was exalted above all the trees of the field; its boughs were multiplied, and its branches became long because of the abundance of water, as it sent them out. **All the birds of the heavens made their nests in its boughs**; under its branches all the beasts of the field brought forth their young; and in its shadow all great nations made their home.

Ezekiel 17:22-24

Thus says the Lord GOD: “I will take also *one* of the highest branches of the high cedar and set *it* out. I will crop off from the topmost of its young twigs a tender one, and will plant *it* on a high and prominent mountain. On the mountain height of Israel I will plant it; and it will bring forth boughs, and bear fruit, and be a majestic cedar. Under it will dwell birds of every sort; in the shadow of its branches they will dwell. And all the trees of the field shall know that I, the LORD, have brought down the high tree and exalted the low tree, dried up the green tree and made the dry tree flourish; I, the LORD, have spoken and have done *it*.”

Another parable He spoke to them: "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal till it was all leavened."

...until the Ancient of Days came, and a judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and **the time came for the saints to possess the kingdom.**

... **Then the kingdom** and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, **shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High.** His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey Him.'

Luke 12:32

"Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

2 Timothy 2:11-13

This is a faithful saying:
For if we died with Him,
We shall also live with Him.

The Priest's Responsibilities

A. To be holy

Leviticus 21:1, 6

And the LORD said to Moses, "Speak to the priests, the sons of Aaron, and say to them: '**None shall defile himself... They shall be holy to their God and not profane the name of their God**, for they offer the offerings of the LORD made by fire, *and* the bread of their God; therefore **they shall be holy**.'

Romans 14:7-9

For none of us lives to himself, and no one dies to himself. For if we live, **we live to the Lord**; and if we die, **we die to the Lord**. Therefore, whether we live or die, **we are the Lord's**. For to this end Christ died and rose and lived again, **that He might be Lord** of both the dead and the living.

1 Peter 1:14-16

...as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, *as* in your ignorance; but as He who called you *is* holy, **you also be holy in all your conduct**, because it is written, "*Be holy, for I am holy.*"

C. To offer up sacrifices

1 Peter 2:5

We Communists don't have the time or the money for many movies, or concerts, or T-bone steaks, or decent homes and new cars. We've been described as fanatics. We are fanatics. Our lives are dominated by one great overshadowing factor, the struggle for World Communism..."

"...We Communists have a philosophy of life which no amount of money could buy. We have a cause to fight for, a definite purpose in life. We subordinate our petty, personal selves to a great movement of humanity, and if our personal lives seem hard, or our egos appear to suffer through subordination to the party, then we are adequately compensated by the thought that each of us in his small way is contributing to something new and true and better for mankind..."

“...There is one thing in which I am in dead earnest, that that is the Communist cause. It is my life, my business, my religion, my hobby, my sweetheart, my wife and mistress, my bread and meat. I work at it in the daytime, and dream of it at night. Its hold on me grows, not lessens as time goes on. Therefore I cannot carry on a friendship, a love affair, or even a conversation without relating it to the force which both drives and guides my life...

“...I evaluate people, books, ideas and actions according to how they affect the Communist cause and by their attitude toward it. I've already been in jail because of my ideas, and, if necessary, I'm ready to go before a firing squad.”

For I say to you, that unless your

But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ...

Matthew 9:35

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, **preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease** among the people.

Luke 10:9

And **heal the sick** there, and say to them, '**The kingdom of God has come near to you.**'

Mark 16:20

And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs.

1 Corinthians 2:4-5

And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in **demonstration of the Spirit and of power**, that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but **in the power of God**.

Mark 1:21-27 (cont.)

But Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be quiet, and come out of him!" And when the unclean spirit had convulsed him and cried out with a loud voice, he came out of him. Then they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, "What is this? What new doctrine *is* this? For with authority He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him."

Matthew 9:5-8

"For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"—then He said to the paralytic, "Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." And he arose and departed to his house. Now when the multitudes saw it, they marveled and glorified God, who had given such power to men.

Luke 7:19-22

And John, calling two of his disciples to him, sent them to Jesus, saying, "Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?" When the men had come to Him, they said, "John the Baptist has sent us to You, saying, 'Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?'"

But if I cast out demons with the finger of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you. When a strong man, fully armed, guards his own palace, his goods are in peace. But when a stronger than he comes upon him and overcomes him, he takes from him all his armor in which he trusted, and divides his spoils.

Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.

Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Judges 14:5-6

So Samson went down...to the vineyards of Timnah. Now to his surprise, a young lion came roaring against him. And **the Spirit of the Lord came mightily upon him**, and he tore the lion apart as one would have torn apart a young goat, though he had nothing in his hand.

Ezekiel 36:25-27

Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. **I will put My Spirit within you** and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.

Zechariah 12:10

And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication...

Isaiah 44:3

For I will pour water on him who is thirsty,
And floods on the dry ground;
I will pour My Spirit on your descendants,
And My blessing on your offspring

John 7:37-39

On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, **out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.**" **But this He spoke concerning the Spirit**, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.

Daniel 11:32

Those who do wickedly against the covenant he shall corrupt with flattery; but **the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits.**

Behold, **I give you the authority** to trample on serpents and scorpions, and **over all the power of the enemy**, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.”

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and **in the power of His might**. Put on the whole armor of God, **that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil**.

You do not have because you do not ask. **You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss**, that you may spend it on your pleasures. Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, “The Spirit who dwells in us yearns jealously”?

Acts 8:18-21

And when Simon [the sorcerer] saw that through the laying on of the apostles’ hands the Holy Spirit was given, he offered them money, saying, “Give me this power also, that anyone on whom I lay hands may receive the Holy Spirit.” But Peter said to him, “Your money perish with you, because you thought that the gift of God could be purchased with money! You have neither part nor portion in this matter, **for your heart is not right in the sight of God**.

Matthew 17:18-20

And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour. Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?" So Jesus said to them, "**Because of your unbelief.**"

James 1:6-8

But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

Luke 18:1ff

He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and **not lose heart.**

And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with God and with men, and have prevailed."

Isaiah 64:7

And there is no one who calls on Your name, who stirs himself up to take hold of You; for You have hidden Your face from us, and have consumed us because of our iniquities.

1 Kings 18:41-45

Then Elijah said to Ahab, "Go up, eat and drink; for there is the sound of abundance of rain." So Ahab went up to eat and drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; then he bowed down on the ground, and put his face between his knees, and said to his servant, "Go up now, look toward the sea."

So he went up and looked, and said, "There is nothing." And seven times he said, "Go again."

1 Kings 18:41-45 (cont.)

If you really fulfill **the royal law** according
to the Scripture,
"You shall love your neighbor as yourself,"
you do well.

James 1:25

But he who looks into **the perfect law of liberty**
and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer
but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in
what he does.

James 2:12

So speak and so do as those who will be judged by
the law of liberty.

Matthew 5:3, 10

Blessed are the poor in spirit,
For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are those who are persecuted for
righteousness' sake,
For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 5:19-20

Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of
these commandments, and teaches men so,
shall be called **least in the kingdom of
heaven**; but whoever does and teaches them,
he shall be called **great in the kingdom of
heaven**. For I say to you, that unless your
righteousness exceeds the righteousness of
the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no
means **enter the kingdom of heaven**.

Matthew 6:9-10

In this manner, therefore, pray:

Our Father in heaven,
Hallowed be Your name.
Your kingdom come...

Matthew 6:33

But **seek first the kingdom of God**
and His righteousness,
and all these things shall be added to you.

Matthew 7:21

Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,'
shall **enter the kingdom of heaven**, but he
who does the will of My Father in heaven.

Matthew 5:17

Do not think that I came to **destroy** the Law
or the Prophets.
I did not come to destroy but to **fulfill**.

Hebrews 7:11-12

Therefore, if perfection were through the
Levitical priesthood (for under it the people
received the law), what further need was
there that another priest should rise
according to the order of Melchizedek, and
not be called according to the order of Aaron?
For the priesthood being changed, of
necessity **there is also a change of the law**.

Colossians 2:16-17

So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or
regarding a festival or a new moon or
sabbaths, **which are a shadow** of things to
come, but **the substance is of Christ**.

1 Corinthians 9:19-21

For though I am free from all men, I have
made myself a servant to all, that I might win
the more; and to the Jews I became as a Jew,
that I might win Jews; to those who are under
the law, as under the law, that I might win
those who are under the law; to those who
are without law, as without law (**not being
without law toward God, but under law
toward Christ**), that I might win those who
are without law.

Matthew 28:18-20

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe **all things that I have commanded you...**"

Matthew 22:35-40

Then one of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question, testing Him, and saying, "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?"

Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' **On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.**"

Romans 13:8-10

Owe no one anything except to love one another, for **he who loves another has fulfilled the law.** For the commandments, "You shall not commit adultery," "You shall not murder," "You shall not steal," "You shall not bear false witness," "You shall not covet," and if there is any other commandment, are all summed up in this saying, namely, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore **love is the fulfillment of the law.**

Galatians 5:14

For **all the law is fulfilled in one word,**
even in this:
"You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Deuteronomy 6:4-5

"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD *is* one! **You shall love the LORD your God** with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.

Leviticus 19:18

You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but **you shall love your neighbor as yourself:**
I am the LORD.

Luke 3:10-11

So the people asked [John the baptist], saying,
"What shall we do then?"

He answered and said to them, "He who has
two tunics, let him give to him who has none;
and he who has food, let him do likewise."

John 13:34-35

A new commandment I give to you, that you
love one another; as I have loved you, that you
also love one another. By this all will know that
you are My disciples, if you have love for one
another."

Romans 12:10

Be kindly affectionate to one another with
brotherly love, **in honor giving preference to
one another.**

1 John 3:16-17

By this we know love, because He laid down
His life for us. **And we also ought to lay
down our lives for the brethren.** But
whoever has this world's goods, and sees his
brother in need, and shuts up his heart from
him, how does the love of God abide in him?

Romans 7:9-11

I was alive once without the law, but when
the commandment came, sin revived and
I died. And **the commandment**, which
was to bring life, **I found to bring death.**
For sin, taking occasion **by the
commandment**, deceived me, and by it
killed me.

2 Corinthians 3:3-6

...clearly you are an epistle of Christ,
ministered by us, written not with ink but **by
the Spirit of the living God**, not on tablets of
stone but on tablets of flesh, that is, **of the
heart...** but our sufficiency is from God, who
also made us sufficient as ministers of the
new covenant, not of the letter but of the
Spirit; for **the letter kills**, but the Spirit gives
life.

1 Corinthians 16:14

"Let all that you do be done with love."

Ephesians 3:17

...that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love...

Matthew 7:12

Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets.

2 Corinthians 11:28-29

...besides the other things, what comes upon me daily: my deep concern for all the churches. Who is weak, and I am not weak? Who is made to stumble, and I do not burn...?

Galatians 5:13

For you, brethren, have been **called to liberty**; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but **through love serve one another**.

John 13:13-17

"You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. **For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.** Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him. **If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.**"

Philippians 2:3-4

Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind **let each esteem others better than himself**. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for **the interests of others**.

1 John 3:16-17

By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?

Romans 14:15

Yet if your brother is grieved because of your food, you are no longer walking in love. Do not destroy with your food the one for whom Christ died.

Matthew 23:23-24

“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithes of mint and anise and cummin, and have neglected the **weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith[fulness]**. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone. Blind guides, who strain out a gnat and swallow a camel!

Micah 6:8

He has shown you, O man, what *is* good;
And what does the Lord require of you
But to do justly,
To love mercy,
And to walk humbly with your God?

John 5:30

I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I judge;
and **My judgment is righteous [just]**,
because I do not seek My own will but the
will of the Father who sent Me.

John 7:24

Do not judge according to appearance, but
judge with righteous [just] judgment."

1 Corinthians 6:1, 5

Dare any of you, having a matter against another, go to law before the unrighteous, and not before the saints?...I say this to your shame. Is it so, that there is not a wise man among you, not even one, who will be able to judge between his brethren?

Luke 6:27-36

"But I say to you who hear: **Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, and pray for those who spitefully use you.** To him who strikes you on the one cheek, **offer the other also.** And from him who takes away your cloak, **do not withhold your tunic** either. **Give to everyone** who asks of you. And from him who takes away your goods **do not ask them back.** And just as you want men to do to you, you also do to them likewise..."

Luke 6:27-36 (cont.)

"But if you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same. And if you lend to those from whom you hope to receive back, what credit is that to you? For even sinners lend to sinners to receive as much back. But **love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing** in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil. **Therefore be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful."**

Matthew 5:33-37

"Again you have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not swear falsely, but shall perform your oaths to the Lord.' But I say to you, do not swear at all: neither by heaven, for it is God's throne; nor by the earth, for it is His footstool; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. Nor shall you swear by your head, because you cannot make one hair white or black. But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No.' For whatever is more than these is from the evil one."

Psalms 15:1, 4

Lord, who may abide in Your tabernacle?
Who may dwell in Your holy hill?

He who swears to his own hurt
and does not change..."

Ephesians 4:15

but, **speaking the truth in love**, [we] may

Proverbs 12:18

There is one who speaks
like the piercings of a sword,
But the tongue of the wise promotes health.

A soft answer turns away wrath,

The words of a talebearer are like tasty trifles,
[traditional Jewish translation: "wounds"]
And they go down into the inmost body.

Like a madman who throws firebrands,
arrows, and death,
Is the man who deceives his neighbor,
And says, "I was only joking!"

Proverbs 27:14

He who blesses his friend with a loud voice,
rising early in the morning,
It will be counted a curse to him.

James 3:6

And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell.

James 1:19

So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, **slow to speak**, slow to wrath

Proverbs 29:11

A fool vents all his feelings,
[“uttereth all his mind”—KJV]
But a wise man holds them back.

Proverbs 17:27-28

He who has knowledge spares his words,
And a man of understanding
is of a calm spirit.
Even a fool is counted wise
when he holds his peace;
When he shuts his lips,
he is considered perceptive.

Mark 10:21

Then Jesus, **looking at him, loved him**, and said to him, “One thing you lack: Go your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, take up the cross, and follow Me.”

Ephesians 4:15

but, speaking **the truth** in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ

Proverbs 27:6

Faithful are the wounds of a friend,
But the kisses of an enemy are deceitful.

Galatians 6:1

Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass,
you who are spiritual restore such a one in a
spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest
you also be tempted.

2 Timothy 2:24-25

And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but
be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, in
humility correcting those who are in
opposition, if God perhaps will grant them
repentance, so that they may know the truth.

1 Peter 3:15

But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and
always be ready to give a defense to everyone
who asks you a reason for the hope that is in
you, **with meekness** and fear

Luke 4:22

So all bore witness to Him, and marveled at the
gracious words which proceeded out of His
mouth.

Ephesians 4:29

Let no corrupt word proceed out of your
mouth, but **what is good for necessary
edification, that it may impart grace** to the
hearers.

Hebrews 10:24, 25

And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works...exhorting one another...

1 John 4:7-8

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and **everyone who loves is born of God** and knows God. **He who does not love does not know God**, for God is love.

1 John 3:14

We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love his brother abides in death.

Galatians 5:22

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love..."

Romans 5:5

Now hope does not disappoint, because **the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit** who was given to us.

2 Timothy 1:7

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and **of love** and of a sound mind.

1 John 5:1-3

Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and **everyone who loves Him who begot [God] also loves him who is begotten of Him [His kids]**. By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and keep His commandments. **For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.**

Luke 9:23

Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him **deny himself, and take up his cross daily**, and follow Me.

Luke 17:8-10

But will he not rather say to him, 'Prepare something for my supper, and gird yourself and serve me till I have eaten and drunk, and afterward you will eat and drink'? Does he thank that servant because he did the things that were commanded him? I think not. So likewise you, **when you have done all those things which you are commanded, say, 'We are unprofitable servants. We have done what was our duty to do.'**"

John 12:26

"If anyone serves Me, **let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also.**"

1 Peter 2:21-23

For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, **leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps**: "Who committed no sin, nor was deceit found in His mouth"; who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously.

1 Corinthians 11:1

"Imitate me, just as I also imitate Christ."
